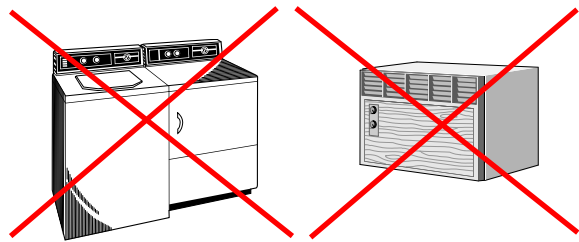

Acceptable items include:

Televisions, including console TVs
VCRs and DVD players
Computers, including monitors, hard
drives, keyboards, mice, printers,
and all hardware
Fax machines, scanners
All cordless appliances
Telephones, Cell phones
Blenders, food processors
Microwaves, toasters
Radios, stereos, CD players
MP3 players
Calculators
GPS units
Vacuums

Unacceptable items include:

Air conditioners
Washers and dryers
Refrigerators
Dehumidifiers
Stoves
Water heaters
Any item that has been stripped of
its cord or other components

Why should you recycle electronics?



Because Illinois has banned the disposal of most electronics in landfills
Because electronic waste represents 2% of all waste, but 70% of toxic waste
Because recycling creates jobs for recyclers and those in the scrap metal and glass business
