## Acceptable items include:

Interior and exterior paints  
Latex, oil, alkyd, and enamel paints  
Porch, floor, and deck paints and stains  
Latex or oil primers and undercoats  
Varnishes and urethanes



## Unacceptable items include:

Spray paint  
Automotive paint  
Mineral spirits and oil-paint removers  
Solvents such as turpentine  
Brushes, rags, and rollers  
Adhesives  
Joint compounds  
Roofing tar  
Window glazing



## Why should you recycle paint?

Because paint is the most prevalent household hazardous waste (by volume)  
Because it takes fewer tax dollars to recycle paint than to carry it to a landfill  
Because the sale of paint cans as scrap metal funds jobs for recyclers



Businesses, schools, and other customers with large quantities  
of paint are asked to call 309-331-4781  
to arrange for a direct collection.
